One other way that students learn prepositions is to learn a lengthy list of them in alphabetical order.

As you have probably learned by now, people all learn differently! Reciting prepositions in ABC order is a good way for students who are auditory learners to learn. However, it is not the best way for learning to "use" prepositions because it does not help you understand the purpose of prepositions.

Do you remember your PPP sentence? Birdie flew \_\_\_\_\_ the tube.

A preposition is a preposition when it has an object following it. In the PPP sentence, the tube is the object of the preposition.
