

FRONT MATTER: PRE-WRITER (Preschool, K, 1st) Christmas Thank-You Cards

Welcome to the almost-done-for-you Christmas thank-you cards for preschool, kindergarten, first grade, and any levels who need messages written for them in dotted lines (handwriting lines) that the kids write over! This Christmas Thank-You Card set is a unique product that will help your kids/students send thank-you notes/cards after Christmas pain-free and without tears! ©

Included in This Set

This packet is chock full—with "dotted messages" and/or "dotted rhyming lines" thank-you notes written inside each card for young ones to simply write over and the following:

•Ten full-colored 4.3 x 5.7 sized brightly-colored cards (five different holiday pictures on the front & five different messages inside)

•Ten full-colored 8x5 sized brightly-colored cards (five different holiday pictures on the front & five different messages inside)

•Ten black-lined 4.3 x 5.7 sized cards to color (five different holiday pictures on the front & five different messages inside)

 \cdot Ten black-lined 8 x 5 sized cards to color (five different holiday pictures on the front & five different messages inside)

·40 total pages of almost-done-for-you Christmas Thank-You cards

Yes, a truly fun way for kids to say thank-you to grandparents, friends, uncles, aunts, etc., without having the hairpulling sessions of getting them to write sentences that they either aren't ready to write or simply have trouble

writing.

The dotted-line letters/words make it simple for these young kids to say thanks.

And for the artistic ones, half the cards have Christmas pictures to color (and the words Thank-You) on the front. For the less artistic (or the "let's just get this done) kids, half of the cards have the pictures on the front in full color.

How to Use the Christmas Thank-You Card Set for Pre-Writers

1)Decide which size cards you want to use.

2)Decide whether you want full-color or black-line to color fronts.

3)Decide which picture(s)/message(s) you want.

4)Decide the weight of paper you will print on (regular paper, colored paper, cards stock, etc.). For nicer-looking cards without any bleed through if students color with markers, I recommend white card stock.

5)Print ones you have chosen two-sided, flipped on long side:

a.In color for the full-color cards.

b.In black and white for the ones kids color.

6)Cut the small cards and fold; simply fold the large cards.

7)Help the child color the front (if black and white one is used)

8)Help the child write over the dotted message on the inside with a pen or pencil.

9)Help them fill in the Dear line at the top and the closing at the bottom (or fill in for them if writing the names are too difficult)

10)Send or pass out the cards in the corresponding size envelopes:

a.Small: 4 3/8" x 5 ¾"

b.Large: 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"

You may also mix and match—color some; print some already colored; use some small cards and some large, etc. Have fun with your kids while teaching them the lost art of thank-you cards!




